When will the new audit platform launch?

The new online audit will be available from Monday 2 March 2026.

Does this mean the new “online” audit will be remote?

No, documenting the audit will now be done online. The only change is the format of the audit report, and the audit process remains the same as before.

What will the new audit process be?

The audit process itself is unchanged.

- Member sponsor initiates the audit and notifies you as the supplier that they require an audit of your site.
- You will be directed to complete the SAQ in the online form.
- When complete, the auditor will perform the audit, verifying your answers.
- When the audit is complete, the onsite CAPA is prepared for the closing meeting, and the report undergoes technical verification.
- The report is approved by the Member sponsor and you, as the supplier.
- You may choose to share this information with any other Member, to help reduce the audit burden on your site.

Will the onsite CAPA also be generated online in 2026?

Yes, the onsite CAPA will be available in the platform.

Is there an offline audit report template?

No, the SAQ and audit are now fully online.

Is it mandatory to have a profile for my company and sites prior to being audited?

Yes, because you will need to complete the SAQ section in the audit. A profile with the PSCI is completely free to use, and provides many benefits to you:

- Share data – share SAQ and audit reports with PSCI member companies
- Attend events – the PSCI hosts webinars, conferences, and workshops. These are online or in person, and registered suppliers can attend for free.
- Take trainings and use expert tools – the PSCI has a range of interactive trainings and expert tools that you may use, for free, to support your journey on responsible business practices.
